Smith Park Renovation

Pavilion • Playground • Sports Courts

With its genesis in the early 1920's, 'City Park' was renamed in 1939 for former Wahoo City Councilman Dr. J.G. Smith. With foresight, patience, and genteel devotion, Smith transformed an unsightly city space into the 'recreation center' of Wahoo...encompassing an entire block.

Today, Smith Park provides active and passive use recreation opportunities for all ages and serves as a hub for downtown activity.

In addition to updated landscaping, hardscaping, and park lighting, project plans include three distinct components:

- 'All-Seasons' Pavilion - to accommodate activities year-round and includes an event patio/stage for outdoor performances
- Playground - with rubberized playing surface
- Sports courts - Basketball and Pickleball
