Donation Amount.....\$1,500



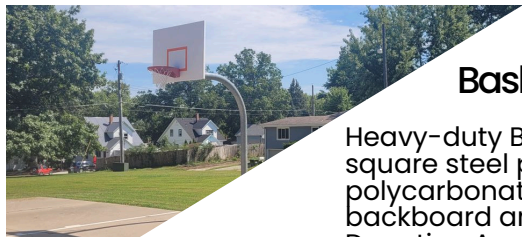
### Park Bench

## Program Details

Contributions and charitable giving to the City enhance the beauty and enjoyment of the City's parks and green spaces. Any individual or group interested in supporting this mission can donate a park amenity.

Donations to Wahoo Parks and Recreation are considered outright and once accepted, become the property of the City of Wahoo. Wahoo Parks and Recreation does not guarantee permanency of the accepted donation. Donors should reference Wahoo Parks and Recreation's "Gifts, Donations & Memorials" Policy for further information and details about the procedures and policies for the acceptance of gifts and donations.

Although the Department is a municipal government entity and not part of a non-profit organization, gifts and donations given to the City of Wahoo can be tax deductible if made solely for "public purposes" such as parks and recreation. The IRS Code, at 26 U.S.C.170(c)(1) defines a "charitable contribution" (which is tax deductible) to include "a contribution or gift to or for the use of a State, a possession of the United States, or any political subdivision of any of the foregoing, or the United States or the District of Columbia, but only if the contribution or gift is made for exclusively public purposes."
